### **CERF Fellowship Scheme**

The CERF Fellowship scheme will renew for its third iteration in Easter 2018. We aim to recruit a new cohort of 10 Fellows. The positions will be advertised on the CJBS and University websites in January 2018, and appointments made in February 2018.

The current cohort includes Fellows from various faculties including CJBS, StasLab, Economics and Land Economy; The fellowship scheme is open to lecturers and senior lecturers who do research into some aspect of finance, and applications will be welcome from all departments of the University of Cambridge.

### **Publications**

Geoffrey Whittington's (CERF Research Associate) latest book ['Value and Profit: An introduction to Measurement in Financial Reporting'](#) was published by the Cambridge University Press.

In this book, Geoffrey Whittington provides a unique survey of the theory and practice of measurement in financial accounts. It seeks to define and illustrate alternative methods, using simple numerical examples, and to analyse their theoretical properties. Also, it summarises extensive empirical evidence and the historical development of ideas and practice.
